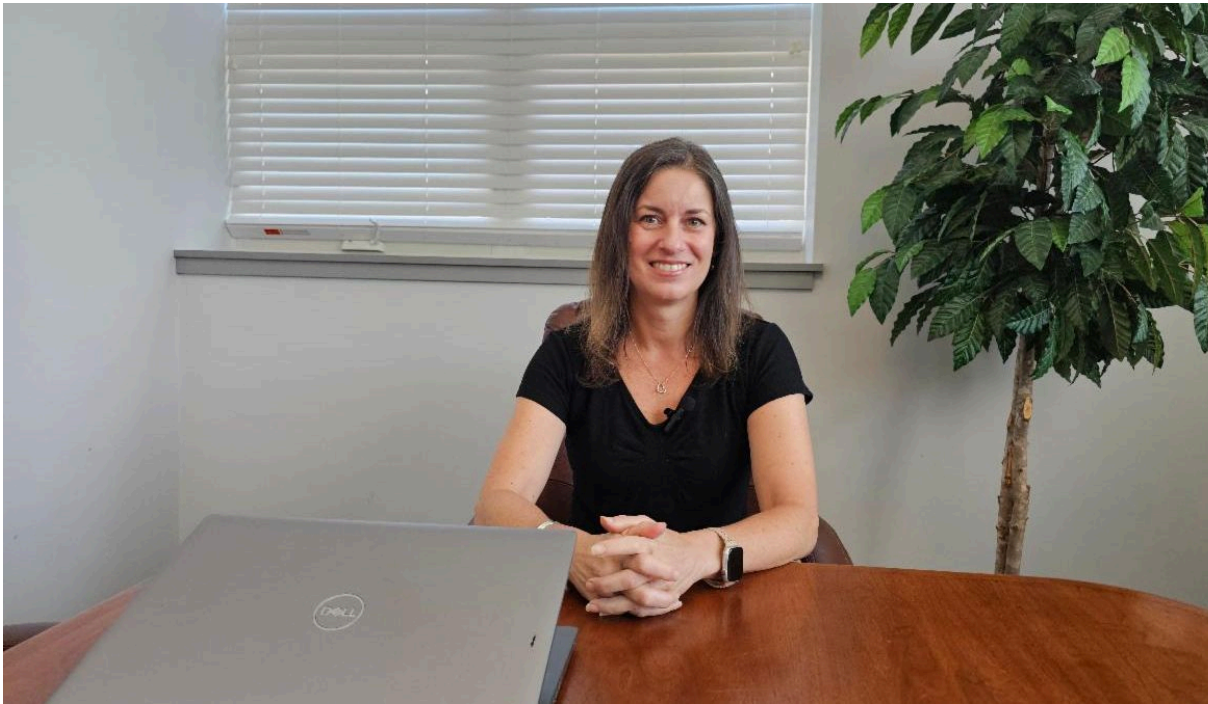

## **The Golden Fine Arts Festival Returns Saturday, August 10 & Sunday, August 11**

This event, rooted in community tradition, offers over 100 artist booth spaces. Artists are chosen through a competitive jury process by art professionals. More than half of the artists come from outside Colorado, while many talented local artists also participate annually.

### **Parking**

Consider walking, cycling, or taking public transit for the festival if you can. For street and parking lot parking, make sure you either have a Golden Resident permit for the first two hours free or register your vehicle for two free hours before paying for additional hours. Pay by kiosk or by QR code. Enforcement will be on so please only park in designated areas. The Marv Kay Stadium Lot (Lot K), at the corner of 11th and Maple Streets, is free for the weekend.

You can also take advantage of the free shuttles departing from the Jeffco Human Services building and RTD/Jeffco Government Building that run from 9:45 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. and will drop you at the Golden Welcome Center. The last shuttle will leave the event entrance at 5:30 p.m.





## Stage 2 Fire Ban in Effect

Golden is under a temporary Stage 2 Fire Ban. Activities prohibited include campfires, charcoal grills, chimeneas or portable outdoor fireplaces, wood or combustible burning fire pits/rings, sky lanterns, Tiki torches, and fire to burn trash, debris, fence rows or vegetation,

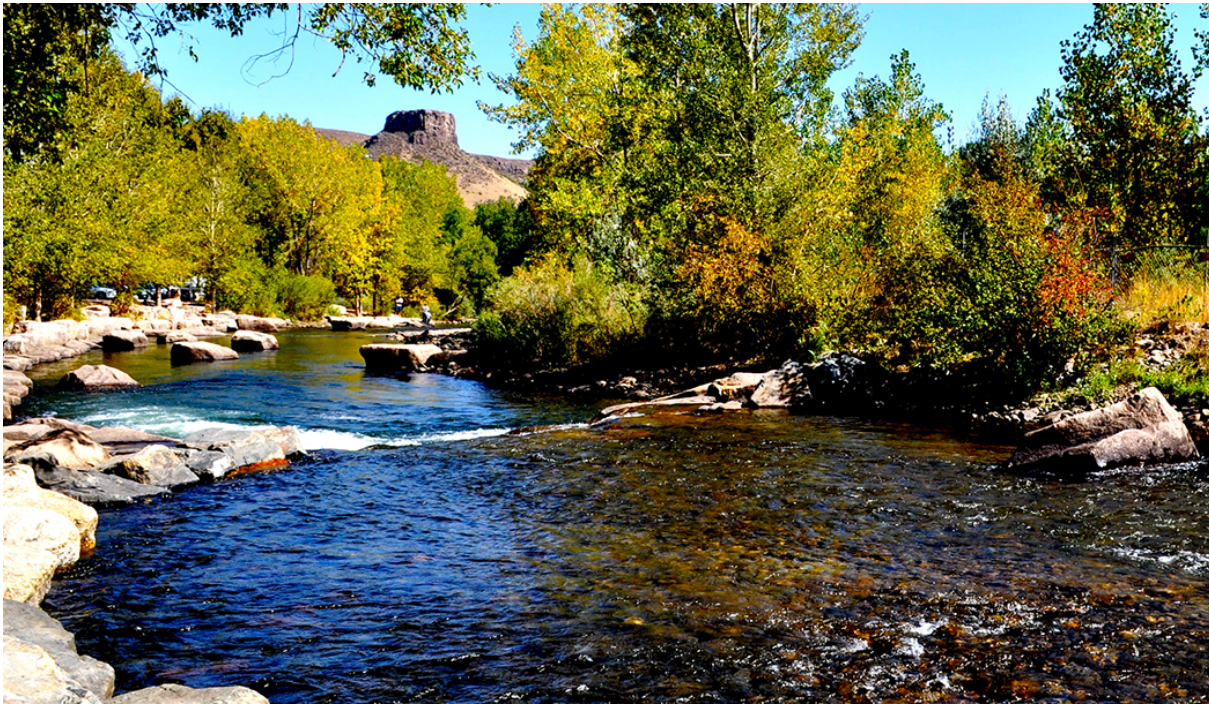


