

New City Partnership with Housing Connector

The City of Golden has partnered with Housing Connector, a tech nonprofit that helps pair people with housing by incentivizing reduced rental screening criteria from rental properties.

If a landlord/property chooses to sign up, this organization offers a risk mitigation package including \$5,000 in risk/damage funding, 3-months of emergency rental assistance, free referrals and Housing Connector Zillow listings, 2-years of customer support, and 2-years of housing stability support for residents.

National Public Lands Day

Please join us this year in celebrating National Public Lands Day on **Saturday**, **September 28**, **8 a.m. to 2 p.m.**! The City will be hosting a major volunteer event to cleanup a 20+mile stretch of the Cleark Creek Corridor, spanning Jefferson and Adams counties. Past event efforts have resulted in the collection of 38,870 pounds of trash.

Mismanaged trash that escapes into waterways can create a wide range of problems. Aquatic trash affects water quality, endangers plants and animals, and pollutes the outdoor spaces that we depend on for tourism and recreation. Volunteers will be removing debris along Clear Creek as well as restoring sensitive habitats.

After the hard work is done, we'll celebrate with an after-party at Clear Creek Valley Park (3700 W 58th Pl. Arvada) for our 400+ volunteers. The celebration will feature free food from local food trucks, complimentary beer for those 21 and over, live music, and exciting prize giveaways.

Clear Creek Update

Over the last week, the creek has begun to see fewer visitors than in the height of summer. Sunday was the busiest day for recreation; water levels are extremely low so less tubing is occurring than on other weekends. Also this weekend, City Code Enforcement team hosted a successful pet vaccine clinic in partnership with Jefferson County.

This coming week, the City expects to see increased use along the creek for the Labor Day weekend. Labor Day also marks the end of the creek season for the City. Residents can expect to see the flags taken down in the days following Labor Day and there will no longer be Creek Ambassadors on the corridor every weekend. Additionally, the parking lot designated for tubing drop-off over the summer on south side of 10th Street next to the baseball fields will go back to its off-season regulations.

The creek season is winding down, but staff are preparing after-summer reports and finalizing data in preparation for the October 8 City Council Study Session.

Concrete Replacement Program


