The event will take place on Kafadar and Stratton Commons, and in front of Guggenheim Hall. There is a road closure associated with this event:

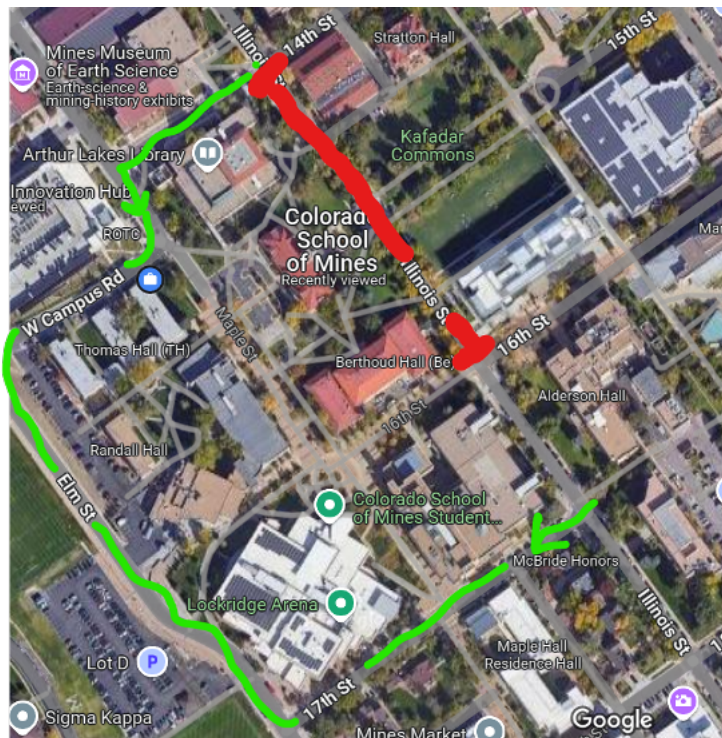
**Closed from 3:30 p.m. to 8:30 p.m.** (event time is 4:30 p.m. to 8 p.m.)

**Illinois Street from 14th Street to 16th Street** (red on map)

**Detours:**

Northbound traffic will be detoured west on 17th St. north on Elm St., east on West Campus Rd, north on Maple St. (green route on map)

Southbound traffic will be detoured west on 14th St., south on Maple St., west on West Campus Rd, south on Elm St. (green route on map)



**Saturday, September 28 from 8:00 to 9:00 AM:** Mines is sponsoring a Homecoming 5K race. 200 participants have signed up for the race. There will be brief rolling road closures associated with this event:

**Street Closures:**

- Illinois St 14th—17th St. (7:45—8:15am)
- Rolling closure at Elm St & 17th

**Closure Details:**

- On Illinois, each cross street, including 11th, is staffed by Mines volunteers and security.
- Each closure has a Mines barricade staffed by volunteers/security.
- Volunteers/security will allow traffic through when there is a break in the flow of racer traffic.
- Runners will be instructed to use the sidewalk where available.
