- The grand opening event for the Tony Grampsas pickleball courts on October 10.





- Pedestrian/bicycle detour to Tucker Gulch trail

East Street/Ford Street

- One lane road with flaggers from 13th Street to 23rd Street

W 4th Avenue

- Full closure of W 4th Avenue from Poppy Street to the development site
- Through November 1
- Monday Friday 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.

- Access and parking to Golden Heights Park still open from W 2nd Place

Washington Avenue

Concrete Replacement Program


