


### Mondays with the Mayor

## Ford Street Closure Update

The Clayworks project requested an extension from the City for the closure of Ford Street (from 7th to 9th Streets) due to unforeseen conditions. The closure will now be in effect from September 27 - October 3 and October 21 - November 8, Monday through Friday, 7 a.m. to 7 p.m.

AC Development crews discovered abandoned utilities, foundation walls, and retaining walls that are interfering with the installation of new utility services. Crews are working to finish up as quickly and safely as possible as Ford Street is a main artery of the City.


