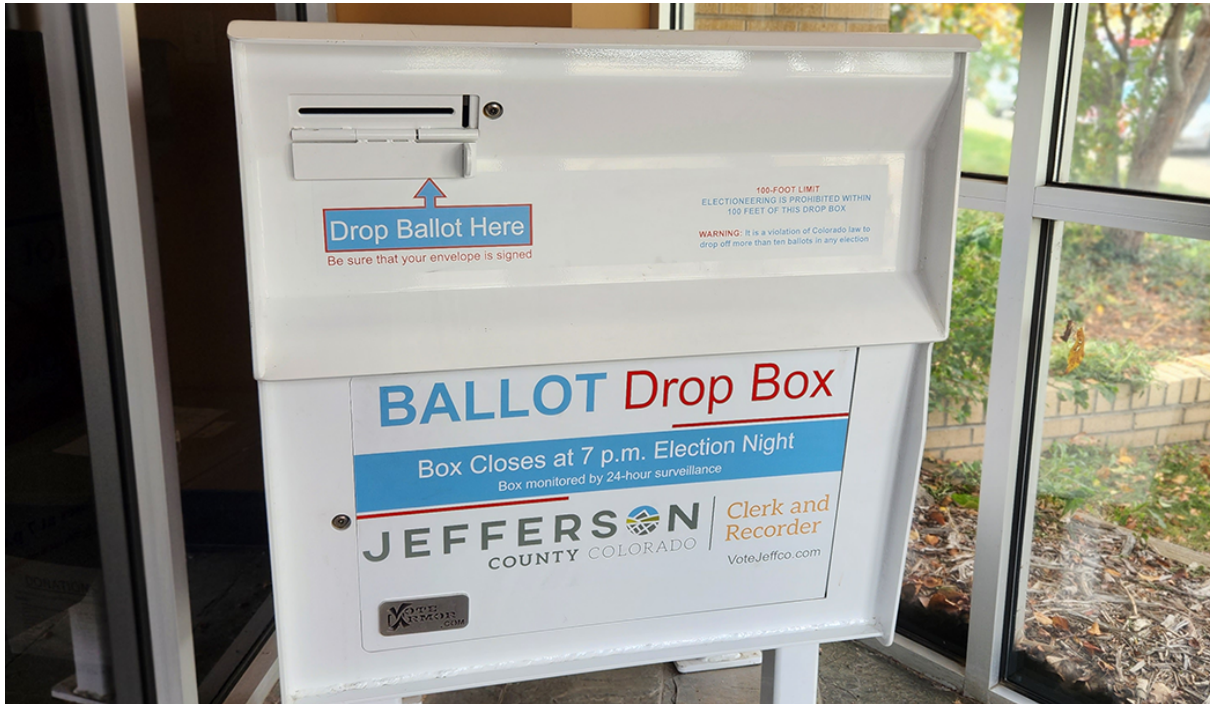
Coffee with Councilors

Right of Way Closures

Full closure of Ford Street from 7th Street to 10th Street

- Full closure of Ford St from 7th St to 10th St
- October 21 through November 8
- Monday – Friday 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.

W 4th Avenue

- Full closure of W 4th Avenue from Poppy Street to the development site
- Through November 1
- Monday – Friday 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.
- Access to Golden Heights Park from W 4th Avenue will be open on weekends
- Access and parking to Golden Heights Park still open from W 2nd Place

Washington Ave – Holiday decor installation

- One lane road with flaggers from 10th St to 11th Street
- Sidewalk closure with a detour to the opposite side of the street
- November 1, 7 a.m. to 7 p.m.

2024 Street Improvement Program




Work is underway on the street paving program. The contractor will distribute door hanger notifications 24 hours in advance to residents on streets that will be paved, along with street sign notifications at least 24 hours in advance for no parking areas or other impacts. Schedules can change on very short notice due to weather, equipment breakdowns, etc., so please pay close attention to the signage provided by the contractor. 
