- Full closure of Heritage Road at Colfax (US Highway 40) south of the Apex parking lot will continue through April.

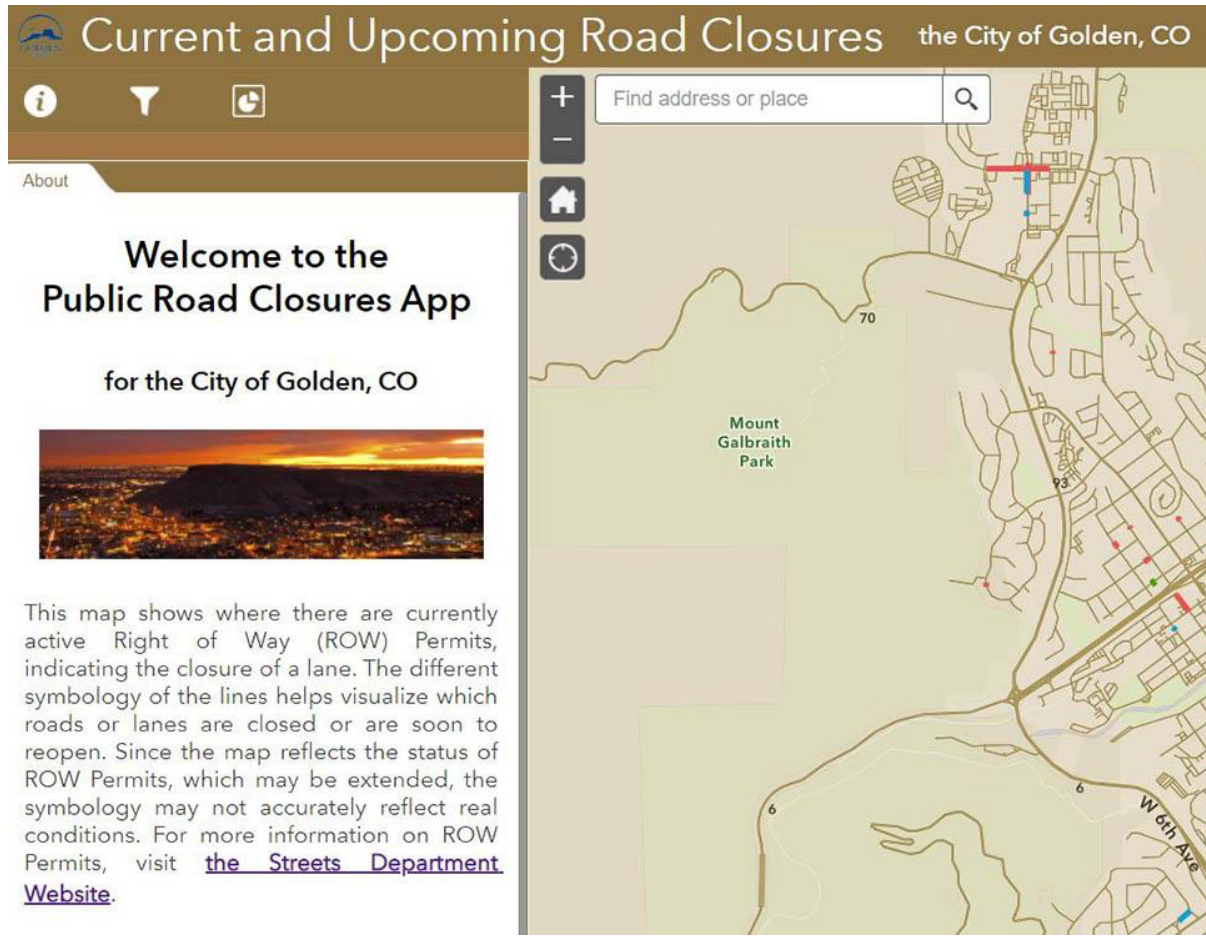
