Colorado School of Mines Celebrates E-days!

The City of Golden is excited to welcome community members to a weekend of innovation, tradition, and celebration as Colorado School of Mines hosts the 90th annual Engineering Days – or E-Days – from Thursday, April 10 through Saturday, April 12.

While many events are reserved for the Mines campus community, several signature activities are open to the public:

Cardboard Boat Races

Saturday, April 12 | 9 a.m.–12 p.m. | Clear Creek near Lions Park

A beloved E-Days tradition, the boat races showcase students' engineering ingenuity with handmade cardboard boats racing down Clear Creek. Duct tape is allowed—but only for adhesive purposes!

E-Days Carnival

Saturday, April 12 | 12–3 p.m. | D Lot (Elm Street), Golden

This family-friendly carnival features food trucks, games, and fun for all ages. Kids under 12 get in free; \$5 entry for others includes food truck access. Guests 21+ can purchase a beer wristband for an additional \$5.

E-Days Fireworks

Saturday, April 12 | 9 p.m. | Viewing from Mines Lot D (Elm Street)

Cap off the celebration with an all-aerial fireworks display designed in part by Mines alumni. The show is expected to be visible throughout Golden—weather permitting—and the public is invited to watch from campus starting at 8:45 p.m.

Ore Cart Reroute

Due to ongoing construction on Arapahoe Street, the 13th & Miners Alley stop on the Ore Cart Gold Route will be temporarily relocated to Washington Avenue & 14th Street through the end of May.

During this time, the Ore Cart will follow a temporary detour, traveling down 14th Street instead of 13th before rejoining its regular route.



Xcel Vegetation Management

Xcel Energy contract crews will be performing important vegetation management work in the eastern region of Golden during April to maintain safe and reliable service within your community and to reduce wildfire risk. The approximate work area will be around the 6th Ave. and I-70 interchange, in the East and West Pleasant View neighborhoods as well as Golden Heights Park.

Crews will be clearing brush, trimming trees and removing hazard trees around power lines. Please be considerate and mindful of their efforts as they work to keep everything running smoothly.






